

General Information about Tuition Payments and Income Eligibility

Cristo Rey Brooklyn is committed to providing affordable Catholic education to our students. All students earn approximately 50% of the cost of their education through the Cristo Rey Brooklyn Corporate Work-Study program. The school does require a contribution for tuition from each family. The amount of tuition for each student is determined on a sliding scale based on your family's annual income. The sliding scale for tuition will range from **\$800** per year to **\$2,500 per year**.

All students admitted to Cristo Rey Brooklyn must demonstrate financial need by meeting the income criteria of the Cristo Rey Network, the national organization which sets the standards for Cristo Rey schools. For admissions to the 2024-2025 school year, your family's annual household income may not exceed the amount shown below in the first column for your household size. A limited number of students whose income does not exceed the amount shown in the second column may also be admitted to the Class of 2028.

All applicants are required to submit their 2022 Federal Income Tax return with their student's application for admission. You must also submit your 2022 W-2 Form to verify your most recent annual income. If you do not file an income tax return or if you do not receive a W-2 Form, please contact the admissions office to discuss alternate forms of income documents that you may submit.

If your child is accepted to CRBHS, you will receive a separate letter indicating the amount of your child's tuition for the year. Tuition will be paid in ten monthly payments from August 2024 through May 2025. Please note that the monthly tuition amounts do not include fees, the **Admissions Director** will send out a letter indicating any fees for the school year. Should your family experience unexpected hardships which affect your ability to pay tuition, you are always welcome to contact the admissions office for a confidential meeting to work out an adjusted payment plan.
