Our Families

Families of CRB students pay an annual average of \$1,300 towards their student's education, up to a *maximum* of \$2,500. The cost of educating a CRB student is approx. \$17,000 per year.

Corporate Work Study (CWS)

Each of our students works one day a week at companies in all five boroughs around New York City, e.g. our freshmen work on Mondays. Income from partners enables our students to self-fund part of their education. We currently have almost 70 partnerships, ranging from major financial institutions to law firms, hospitals and government agencies. To support this, our five person, full time CWS team is dedicated to developing new partnerships and supporting our students and existing CWS partners to get the most possible out of their experiences.

In the past 6 months, CWS have coordinated field trips to Google, NBC, Spotify, NBA and Pratt Institute.
