Honored for their charity work and dedication to young lives were **Chuck and Amanda Schumacher**.

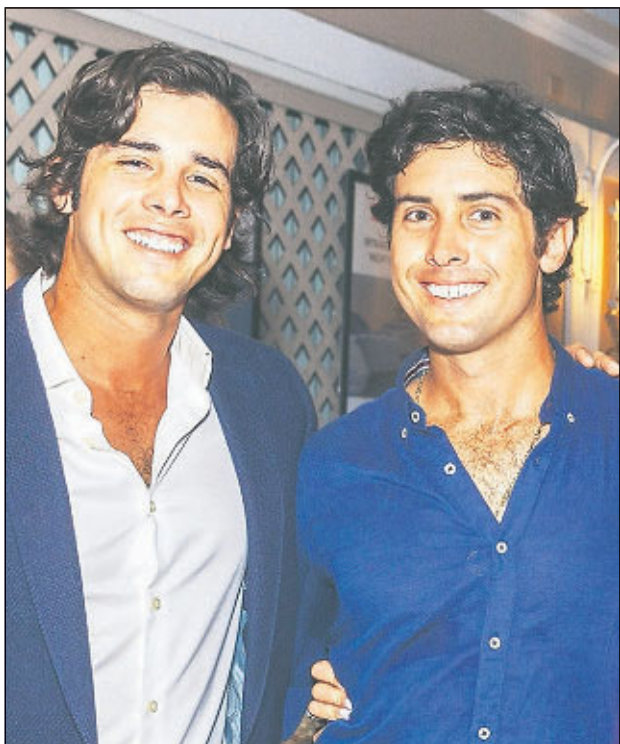
Polo-playing brothers **Carlos and Mariano ("Memo") Gracida** were
